Annual Report for the Academic Year 2013 - 2014

Respected chair, Dr. Ravi M. Nair, esteemed Chief Guest, Prof. V. Madhusoodanan Nair, renowned Malayalam Poet, Rev. Sr. Mable, Dr. P. Jayalal, Dr. Asha M. Nair, Dr. Nishma Jones & Miss. Sankareswari, dear parents, loving students, learned faculty, sincere staff members, media persons, ladies and gentlemen.

I am here to present the Annual Report of the College for the year 2013 – 2014. I don't propose to deal with the report in detail as it is very prolonged and tiring to you. I, therefore, propose to confine myself to a few dominant features of the report in a nut shell.

At the outset itself, I would like to welcome you all in having accepted our invitation.

This report relates to the period from 26th May 2013, the succeeding day of our last year's College Day Celebrations to this year's Celebrations.

Our College has made a thorough development and it is now in an upswing mood to be reckoned as the first of its kind in the country in every respect.

I deem this occasion as one of the happiest one in my life. I now feel fully satisfied in being at the top of this institution to enjoy the bliss of its full bloom. It is only thirteen years since this College was started. Within this short span the institution has not faltered at any stage of its development.

It was continuous and incessant. The maximum admission strength in U.G. course in Homoeopathy has been fixed as 100 by the Govt. of India. This attainment has already been achieved by our College since 2010. Further to this development, I feel it highly creditable to point out that we have been able to start P.G. courses in 4 disciplines for the 1st time under the Tamil Nadu M.G.R. Medical University as far back as 2010. In the meantime we have since added a P.G. course in the subject Repertory too. This has enhanced the total number of P.G. admissions to 30 per annum.

It is a matter of pride to me to make you know that all the infrastructural facilities insisted on by the CCH through the Minimum Standards Education Regulations in Homoeopathy as amended in March 2013 and P.G. Regulations in March 2012 have since been provided in full in the various teaching Departments and Hospital.

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The CCH inspectors were fully convinced of the availability of infrastructures and staff well beyond the Regulatory requirements in their Inspections on 30th October 2013 and 14th February 2014. In addition to the CCH inspections the Tamil Nadu Dr. M.G.R. Medical University also conducted its inspection on 26th November 2013 for granting continuous affiliation to the P.G. courses.

Let me come to the health care activities of our Institution. As per the new Regulations, even though 100 beds are not required in the Collegiate Hospital we have already provided 100 beds with all necessary amenities. There are 11 OPD Units functioning in general for medical, surgical and gynecological conditions. In addition to these there are Dental Clinic, ENT Clinic, Community Medicine Clinic, Mother and Child Clinic besides Physiotherapy Unit in our hospital. The hospital is functioning very efficiently and systematically with diagnostic facilities like, Clinical Lab, X-ray, Ultra Sound Scan, Dispensary, Pharmacy etc.

Over and above these, there are 15 Peripheral Health Centres in and around the College in the District of Kanyakumari. Besides, there have been 3 centres at Chithiramcode, Perimchilambo and Mekkamandapam to look after the health care of the mentally challenged in an elegant manner.

The tie-up facilities with the Gerdi Gutperle Agasthiyar Muni Child Care Centre, Vellamadam have been going on in a more and more progressive way. This year we started an exclusive homoeopathic Unit in that hospital to run regularly from Monday to Saturday as against the functioning of only one day on Saturday. It has done a lot of benefits to our P.G. students in Paediatrics. This is entirely due to the goodness and wishes on the part of Rev. Fr. Hieronimus, Director of that Institute. We have every right to hope that boundless help from that Centre will continue to bless us in future too.

We have got another tie-up with Benzam Hospital, Nagercoil which is also going on from better to best. Our Internees are getting trained there in Surgery and OBG.

As part of our academic courses, we have been conducting regular family health surveys, health awareness programmes, medical camps, preventive camps etc. in optimum level. Apart from these, we have School Health Programmes centred round three Schools in the near by area namely Chitharal, Thirparappu and Attoor.

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We are running a Mother & Child Clinic in our hospital as per the instruction of the Central Council of Research in Homoeopathy, Govt. of India as part of the National Campaign on Homoeopathy for Mother and Child Health Care. We started a Pain and Palliative care clinic in our Hospital with the Collaboration of the "Pallium Kulasekharam", an organization similar to that of Pallium India. A workshop on "Essential Pain Management" was also conducted in the College on 26th Feb. 2014 as part of developing our teaching faculty to manage this clinic.

It is in addition to all these activities that we have been conducting N.S.S. Programmes with annual camps consisting of Health Survey, Health education programmes, distribution of pamphlets, conduct of exhibition etc. with the assistance of the Tamil Nadu Dr. M.G.R. Medical University. This is only a small depiction of community oriented programmes undertaken by our College.

This college has also taken special interest in conducting Guest Lecture Programmes for the benefit of the P.G. students. Such programmes were 13 in numbers. Experts from different parts of India were drafted to these programmes. There is also a record of two workshops having conducted for the PG Students during the period.

One of the most significant events of this year was the holding of a Workshop on Homoeopathic Medical Education Technology on Clinical practice and Training to the teachers of Homoeopathy. It was conducted here on 26th and 27th August 2013 by the Central Council of Homoeopathy. This Workshop registered a participation of teachers from various colleges in South India. The President, Vice-President and other senior members of the CCH besides a host of other talented and erudite personalities attended and guided the Workshop.

This year is worth focusing in that our students have banked an overall Trophy in the South Indian Inter Homoeo Collegiate meet held at Sree Vidhiyathiraja Homoeo Medical College, Thiruvananthapuram on 22nd and 23rd November 2013. I would like to seize this opportunity once again to congratulate the student winners of our college and the teachers who were instrumental for reaping such glorious victory.

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The college prepared Log Book, Diary for House Job, Training Records for PG programme and got them approved by the University. Unlike other PG colleges in Homoeopathy all the above things have been put into practice systematically here. The college has since prepared calendar with sumptuous features regarding the College, courses of studies and curricular and extra curricular activities.

Coming to the U.G. courses, there have also been varied programmes directed towards improving the standard of students during the period under report. The conduct of study tours, sending students to other colleges for participating in competitive programmes, guest lecture programmes, seminars etc. are some shining illustrations to the credit of our college.

The internship programme for the UG students is also on the smooth go in a disciplined manner. We have chalked out a unique way for preparation of assignments under the direct guidance of teachers during the internship training. I am proud to point out here that these things are of special nature to our own college. All these assignments are being preserved as a token of their valuable assets of our college.

The top rank holders and best students of each course including P.G. are awarded with deserving mementos and titles every year on the College Day celebrations. This will be done today also. I congratulate in advance this year's recipients.

It is a permanent routine feature with our college to conduct Arts and Sports festival every year in a very systematic and arranged manner. The winners are being honoured with distributing prizes on the College Day Celebrations.

Sports Meet of this year titled "Conjura 2014" was conducted from 30th April to 3rd May and Arts Festival named "Sathgamaya 2014" was also held from 19th to 22nd of May successfully. The winners will be honoured with prizes in this function.

We celebrated Hahnemann's Birthday of this year on 09th April 2014, prior to one day on account of polling of General Election in Kerala on 10th April. The College Foundation Day on 1st November 2012 with a variety of programmes was celebrated. We also celebrated Freshers Day on 27.11.2013.

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This period also witnessed one convocation ceremony held on 1st November 2014 awarding degree certificates to 39 U.G. & 22 P.G passed out students. This event includes the convocation of the first batch of P.G. holders under our University. We are all happy and feel fortunate in having been able to conduct it here itself.

We have always been keeping up a trend of better percentage of pass in all the University Examinations ever since the inception of the college. This year also we have maintained the same trend even in the P.G. Programmes too.

To substantiate the above claims I shall furnish hereunder the following statistical data.

The academic year for 2013-14 began with the starting of classes for II, III and IV BHMS on 15.04.2013, 11.03.2013 and 11.03.2013 respectively.
