Annual Report for the Academic Year 2014 – 2015

Respected chair, Dr. Ravi M. Nair, esteemed Chief Guest, Prof. (Dr.) A.M. Vasudevan Pillai, renowned Malayalam Novelist and Critique, Dr. P.K. Sukumaran Nair, Chairman, Pallium Kulasekharam, Dr. Jomy George, Dr. R. Ramesh Prabhu, Dr. D. Chiristi Sam, Miss. Vineetha Sreekumar, dear parents, loving students, learned faculty, sincere staff members, media persons, ladies and gentlemen.

I am here to present the Annual Report of the College for the year 2014 – 2015. I don't propose to deal with the report in detail as it is very prolonged and tiring to you. I, therefore, propose to confine myself to a few dominant features of the report in a nut shell.

At the outset itself, I would like to welcome you all in having accepted our invitation.

This report relates to the period from 25th May 2014, the succeeding day of our last year's College Day Celebrations to this year's ones.

Our College has made a thorough development and it is now in an upswing mood to be reckoned as the first of its kind in the country in every respect.

I am proud enough to be here today to present this report revealing the steady progress of this College to its present status. I now feel fully satisfied in being at the top of this institution to enjoy the bliss of its full bloom. It is only fifteen years since this College was started. Within this short span, the institution has not faltered at any stage of its development.

Number of students admitted:

Our college has been able to catch up with the maximum 100 number admission in U.G. course and six in P.G. batch in each of the five disciplines, thus totalling the number of annual intake of students to 130.

Inspections by the Authorities

It is a matter of pride to me to make you know that all the infrastructural facilities as per the existing CCH Minimum Standards Education Regulations in Homoeopathy and P.G. Regulations have since been provided in full in the various teaching Departments and Hospital.

The CCH inspectors were fully convinced of the availability of infrastructures and staff well beyond the Regulational requirements in their Inspection on 4th Feb. 2015. In addition to the CCH inspections the Tamil Nadu Dr. M.G.R. Medical University also conducted its inspections on 11th June 2014 and 10th March 2015 for granting continuous affiliation to the P.G. courses.

Health Care Activities

The college has unleashed many health care activities in accordance with the new Regulations. The hospital has 100 beds, 15 OPD units, clinics in Dental, ENT, Community Medicine, Mother & Child Health care besides a Physiotherapy unit. The hospital has also provided diagnostic facilities like clinical Lab, X-ray, Ultra Sound Scan etc. besides dispensary, and pharmacy. 18 Peripheral Health Centres are also at work in and around the College. Necessary tie-up facilities have also been fostered with the Gerdi Gutperle Agasthiyar Muni Child Care Centre, Vellamadam rendering benefit to our P.G. students in Paediatrics. Again our interneees are getting trained in Surgery and OBG through another tie-up with Benzam Hospital, Nagercoil.

We are running a Mother & Child Clinic in our hospital as per the instructions of the Central Council of Research in Homoeopathy, Govt. of India as part of the National Campaign on Homoeopathy for Mother and Child Health Care. We started a Pain and Palliative Care Clinic in our Hospital with the Collaboration of the "Pallium Kulasekharam", an organization similar to that of Pallium India in 2013. It is conducted in a progressive way in every fortnight under the guidance of Dr. P.K. Sukumaran Nair, Paediatrician, National Health Service, United Kingdom who is one of our guests today to felicitate this function.

In addition to this, a speciality clinic on cancer has also been set up in the Hospital which has been functioning regularly for the last 6 months under the guidance of Dr. N.V. Sugathan, D.M.S. of hospital. Along with this Unit, facilities for OP & IP for cancer treatment both palliative and curative with Homoeopathic medicines are also undertaken. It has since been proved that Homoeopathic medicines are efficacious in this field also.

A speciality clinic on Fertility was also started on 4th May 2015. A Paediatrics Rehabilitation Unit for Physically challenged children due to Cerebral Palsy and other nervous disorders also began functioning on the same day.

As part of our academic courses, we have been conducting regular family health surveys, health awareness programmes, medical camps, preventive camps etc. in optimum level. Apart from these, we have School Health Programmes centred round three Schools in the near by area namely Chitharal, Thirparappu and Attoor.

It is in addition to all these activities that we have been conducting N.S.S. programmes with annual camps consisting of Health Survey, Health education programmes, distribution of pamphlets, conduct of exhibition etc. with the assistance of the Tamil Nadu Dr. M.G.R. Medical University. This is only a small depiction of community oriented programmes undertaken by our College.

P.G. Programmes

This college has also taken special interest in conducting Guest Lecture Programmes for the benefit of the P.G. students. Such programmes were 13 in numbers. Experts from different parts of India were drafted to these programmes. There is also a record of three workshops having conducted for the PG Students during the period. One of the Workshops was a two days programmed guided by Dr. C.B. Nayak, former Director General of CCRH, Govt. of India.

As required by the national Govt. an Institutional Ethical Committee for medical Research was formed with Dr. B. Krishna Prasad, Principal (Rtd.), N.V.K.S.D. College of Education, Attoor, K.K. Dist. as its Chairman and 13 other members in close conformity with the norms stipulated by the Govt. of India. Again, an Institutional Research Committee was also formed with Dr. M. Murugan, Prof. & Ho.D of Organon of Medicine as its Chairman for giving proper guidance in the research activities of this institution.

U.G. Programmes

Coming to the U.G. courses, there have also been varied programmes directed towards improving the standard of students during the period under report. The conduct of study tours, sending students to other colleges for participating in competitive programmes, guest lecture programmes, seminars etc. are some shining illustrations to the credit of our college.

It is here befitting to record the fact of our students having secured the overall second runner up position in the Inter Collegiate Sports meet held at Martin Homoeopathic Medical College, Coimbatore on 15th & 16th December 2014. The winners and the staff who were behind this victory deserve our hearty congratulations.

The internship programme for the UG students is also on the smooth go in a disciplined manner. We have chalked out a unique way for preparation of assignments under the direct guidance of teachers during the internship training. I am proud to point out here that these things are of special nature to our own college. All these assignments are being preserved as a token of their valuable assets of our college.

Short Term Studentship in Homoeopathy

With a view to making U.G. students research oriented by creating genuine interest in research activities, Central Council for Research in Homoeopathy (CCRH), Govt. of India launched a programme - "Short term Studentship in Homoeopathy" for the first time in India last year. Students were selected from all over India on the basis of their project reports.

Our college got two students Miss. Neethu Mohan (Third year) and Miss. Justina M. Stephen (Third Year) selected for the programme out of a total number of 18 candidates at national level. They have already submitted their theses which are understood to be engaging scrutiny by the CCRH. It is happy to see that the theses are receiving good comments from the CCRH. I would here to congratulate those students along with their guides Dr. Sathish M. Nair (Lecturer Dept. of Organon), Dr. Abhijith C. Nair (Lecturer, Dept. of Surgery) and the research officer Dr. C.V. Chandraja for their efforts in making these projects a grand success.

Functions and Celebrations

The 14th annual College foundation day was celebrated on 1st November 2014 with various functions as usual. A convocation ceremony was also held on the same day awarding BHMS Degree Certificates to 41 students and M.D. (Hom) ones to 24 passed out students. Shri. T.K.A. Nair I.A.S. (Rtd.), Former Principal Secretary / Advisor in Prime Minister's office, Delhi was the Chief Guest on that occasion.

A welcome reception was given to Dr. Ramjee Singh and Dr. Arun Bhasme on their re-election as President and Vice - President of the CCH respectively on 1st December 2014. It was attended by the Principals of the majority Homoeopathic Medical Colleges in Tamil Nadu. Following this a two days Workshops in Research Methodology under the auspices of the CCH for P.G. Teachers was also conducted. It was attended by P.G. Teaching faculty of various Homoeopathic Medical Colleges in South India.

Again the Education Committee of the CCH was held in our College on 3rd December 2014. We also celebrated Freshers' Day on 19.12.2014.

This year's World Homoeopathy Day was celebrated on 10th April by all students, faculty and staff wearing the badges with the inscription - "Homoeopathy for food safety". On April 11th, 260th Hahnemann's birth anniversary was also celebrated with various functions. Dr. Soumendu Adhikari, Rtd. Prof. of NIH, Kolkata was the Guest who delivered this year's Hahnemann memorial speech.

Prizes and Awards

The top rank holders and best students of each course including P.G. are awarded with deserving mementos and titles every year on the College Day celebrations. This will be done today also. I congratulate in advance this year's recipients.

It is a permanent routine feature with our college to conduct Arts and Sports festival every year in a very systematic and arranged manner. The winners are being honoured with awarding prizes on the College Day Celebrations.

Sports Meet of this year titled "Esperanza 2015" was conducted from 29th April to 1st May and Arts Festival named "Malhaar 2015" was also held from 18th to 21st of May successfully. The winners will be honoured with prizes in this function.

University Exam Result

We have always been keeping up a trend of better percentage of pass in all the University Examinations ever since the inception of the college. This year also we have maintained the same trend even in the P.G. Programmes too.
