Health Care Activities including Community Health care outreach activities

Our Collegiate Hospital has 100 beds with 23 OPD units, Specialty Clinics, including Dental, Physiotherapy, Mother and child Health Care, Diabetic Food Care. Hospital infrastructure includes, air-conditioned mini operation theatre, Labour Room and I. C. Unit.

There are 27 peripheral Health Centers across the district, besides tie up facilities with the Gerdi Gupterle Agasthiyar Muni Child Care Centre, Vellamadam and Bensam Hospital Nagercoil.

Also we have been conducting regular family Health Surveys, Health awareness programmes medical camps, preventive camps and School health Programmes. As part of the learning disability Programme for school children in Kanniyakumari District, we are conducting Awareness Programmes, Screening and training Programmes, besides management of identified learning disabled Children at our collegiate hospital.

Our college has been approved as one of the newly identified Peripheral Pharmacovigilance Centres for Homoeopathy by the Ministry of AYUSH, Govt. of India functioning from 05.10.2019.

Welfare Measures

As part of the welfare measures, for the benefit and well being of the students as well as staff, we have taken special interest to cover all the students and 95% of the willing staff and their family members under Group health and Accident Insurance Coverage, from the year 2015.

Convocation Ceremony

Today we conduct our Convocation Ceremony also separately duly following all the COVID protocol.

Short Term Studentship Programme in Homoeopathy STSH

The STSH programme instituted by the CCRH, Ministry of AYUSH, Government of India, from the year 2014. Sarada Krishna Homoeopathic Medical College has consistently got maximum number of approved projects at National level from the inception of the programme. Due to COVID pandemic STSH programme have not been conducted in 2019.

BHMS Students, whose projects are approved have been invited to participate in the World Homoeopathy Day celebrations usually conducted in Delhi, every year and being awarded merit certificate along with the cash award of Rs 10,000/ each. So far we have gained 86 out of 199 projects approved finally at National Level.

Sarada Krishna Homoeopathic Medical College - Center for Promotion of Yoga Education and practice.

The College has provided facilities for conducting classes on yoga practice for 10 days consecutively from 1st to 10th of every month since 2008 between 6 pm and 8 pm. The classes are conducted under the leadership of Shri .P. Krishnan Kutty, Yoga Expert .These classes are open to staff and students of this college besides the general public.

A ten months course titled Yoga for Youth Empowerment has been going on in SKHMC for the last 4 Years for Interns. In 2020, 10 Interns have completed the course and awarded certificates. (lists of students appended)

Programmes Conducted by Departments

1. National Library week Celebrations

To commemorate the National library week, we have celebrated the National library week from 14th to 21st November 2020. As part of the programme a debate on "Reading habit influenced by digital library or traditional library", essay competition, and general knowledge Quiz Programme have also been conducted.

2. Launching of Drug Proving Programme

With the recognition of the Tamil Nadu Dr. M.G.R. Medical University, Chennai, we have been conducting the Ph.D. programme in 5 P.G. Departments from 2018.

3. Launching of Research oriented specialty clinics

In Continuation of the signing of MOU with CCRH and introduction of Ph.D. course in our college, with the aim of training, Research orientation has been added to the specialty clinics of Backache, Cancer pain and Palliative care, Thyroid disorders, Learning disability, Geriatric care and Preventive cardiology.

4. Launching of Ph.D. programme

The college has got recognition for the Ph.D programmes in five existing PG Departments by The Tamil Nadu Dr.M.G.R Medical University Chennai. We are very proud to observe that our college has been steadily progressing. With 100 UG admission, PG Courses in five disciplines and Ph.D. programme in all PG Departments .

5. Bridge and Foundation course.

We have conducted Bridge and Foundation Course in two batches from one for the students admitted under management quota and the other one for the students admitted later under government quota, for giving orientation to new BHMS Students about the Syllabus and Curriculum. The course include among other things, Foundation for Medical Education, Awareness on Mentoring System, Library and learning, Communication Skills, Yoga Community Oriented activities, languages and culture. The programme is designed with a goal to create transformation from their school education pattern to a professional stream of education.

6.CME Programme

We have been conducting CME programmes sponsored by the Ministry of AYUSH, Govt. of India. As such this year we have conducted a one 6 day CME for Teachers on Repertory (Module II) from 12.08.2021 to 18.08.2021. out of sum of Rs. 6,00,000/- sanctioned by the Govt. of India, Ministry of AYUSH.

Internal Quality Assurance Cell (IQAC)

With a view to internalizing and institutionalizing quality through activating the system and raising the institutional capabilities to higher levels ensuring continuous quality improvement, an IQAC has been functioning in our college since 2015. Several quality initiatives have been undertaken by IQAC including, quality benchmarks and parameters in academic and administration

viz, adoption of best practices, strengthening of assessment and evaluation process, optimization and integration of teaching learning methods, feedback mechanism, academic audit, adoption of ICT, all focusing NAAC accreditation and we have got the NAAC accreditation with B+ grade w.e.f. 31.03.2021.

The college has been participating in the All India Survey on Higher Education from the year 2010-11 and National Institutional Ranking Frame work (NIRF) from the year 2018.

Tie-up Arrangements

The college has effective tie-up arrangements with the Bensam Hospital, Nagercol, where the interns of the college are getting clinical training in Surgery, OBG, Like wise Paediatrics P.G. students getting their clinical studies at Gerdi Gupterle Agasthiar Muni Child Care Centre & Vellamadam. A tie-up facility has also been made with Govt. Medical College, Nagercoil and Govt. Head Quarters Hospital, Padmanabhapuram @ Thuckaly for students observership in OBG and Surgery Depts. and for witnessing postmortem as part of the Syllabus in Forensic Medicine.

As part of the Health care and Academic and Research Oriented out reach activities, we have separate MoUs / Tie-up arrangements with CCRH and more than 27 institutions / organisations / NGOs.
