Medical officer Dr. P.R. Sisir and a team from Benu eye clinic. Around 143 students from 9° to 11° standard of A, B, C division were screened for vision and sexual education given to students. Among them 56 students were found to have visual defects after myopia screening. They were informed about their health status and directed to the Paediatric OP of Sarada Krishna Homoeopathic Medical College Hospital.

Among them 38 students were found to have visual defects, 7 students had reading and writing problems and 2 students had secondary nocturnal enuresis. Among them 35 students were found to have visual defects, 15 students were malnourished and 10 students were found to have poor immunity. They were informed about their health status and directed to the Paediatric OP of Sarada Krishna Homoeopathic Medical College Hospital.
