### Annual Report of Examination Results 2017-18

The college has constituted an Examination Cell to conduct Internal and University examination under the dynamic leadership of Dr. Winston Vargheese, Professor, Dept. of Materia Medica, the other members of the committee are: Dr. Krishna Kumari Amma; Dr. M. Murugan, Dr.T. Jayakumar and Dr. Siju, V. from 2013-14 onwards. The main responsibilities of the Evaluation Cell are to conduct internal and external examination (University Examination). The cell convenes the meeting in the beginning of the academic year and prepared an examination calendar for the year based on Academic Calendar. As a policy, we practice three internal examinations annually in addition to the University Examination. For the academic year, 2017-18, we have successfully implemented CCIE (Continuous and Comprehensive Internal Evaluation). Schedule for internal and external examination for the year were December 2017, March 2018, June 2018 and September 2018. As a part of CCIE, respective departments were conducted monthly test, seminar, group discussion, assignments, quizzes, and evaluation of students by Teachers. The questions papers are prepared by the concerned department and conduct the examination by the cell, similar to the University Examinations. Attendance is compulsory, separate exam will be conducted for defaulters. The marks scored by the students are displayed on respective Department Notice Board and informed to their parents through SMS. Remedial teachings were given to the students who got less than 25 % marks in their Term Test.
