The following programmes were conducted

**14<sup>th</sup> November-2018**

The inaugural function was conducted at 10.00am in the Research section. Dr.P.R.Sisir, Faculty in-charge of Central Library welcomed the guests, faculty and students. The programme was inaugurated by lighting the "Kuthuvilakku" by Dr.C.K.Mohan, Principal. The father of Library Science, Dr.S.R.Ranganathan's portrait was garlanded by Dr.P.Saravanan, Chief Librarian, Lekshmipuram college of Arts and Science. He congratulated the management and members of the library committee for uplifting the Central Library.

**15<sup>th</sup> November-2018**

A debate was conducted in the Librray Hall at 2.00pm on the Topic "Reading habit influenced by digital library or traditional library". It was moderated by Dr.P.Saravanan. Dr.Krishna Prasad, Principal, ST Hindu College, Nagercoil also participated in the Programme. Twenty students participated from all batches who were divided into two teams. They spoke positively and negatively about the digital library and traditional library effectively. Dr.Krishna Prasad spoke about How is the digital library useful for students as compared to the traditional manual library. He added that although digital library provides easy access, fast search and a lot of related materials But the feeling of holding a book and intellectual environment of traditional libraries cannot be replaced by digital libraries.

### **16<sup>th</sup> November-2018**

An awareness programme was conducted on the Topic "Importance of library" was presented by Dr.P.Saravanan for the I-BHMS students in their Lecture Hall. He spoke about importance of reading and how to improve the reading skill. Then he spoke about importance digital library in the modern world.

### **19<sup>th</sup> November-2018**

An Essay writing competition was held at 2.00pm in the Central Library on the Topic " **Library transforms the life**". Twenty students participated. Miss.A.Kiruthika Sakthi from IV BHMS got 1st Prize Miss.Pragadhee.S from III BHMS got 2nd Prize and Miss.Naga Suvedha.S and Mr.G.G.Tejas Vikas from II BHMS got 3rd prize for the competition.

### **26<sup>th</sup> November-2018**

A "book Review" was conducted by Dr.Ayyalammai.M (P.G.Scholar) and Dr.Abhijith Ranjan.S(P.G.Scholar) in the Presence of Dr.P.R.Sisir. The name of the book is French's Index of Differential Diagnosis. The Author of the book is Herbert French. He had won university scholarship for medical education. In 1912 he published An Index of Differential Diagnosis of Main symptoms.

French's Index of Differential Diagnosis helps the clinicians of any condition which may be seen in hospital or general practice. The text helps the reader identify each presentation, describes the different diagnosis that would represent , and explains the tests used to make a diagnosis. Colour photographs help with diagnosis at a glance.

The book is completely revised many sections and largely rewritten, new ones added, diagnostic methods updated, many old illustrations replaced and others inserted. The emphasis, however, remains the same, the importance of careful history, detailed clinical examination and judicious use of laboratory and imaging investigation in the elucidation of the correct diagnosis.

### **28<sup>th</sup> November-2018**

A General knowledge Quiz programme titled as **Interrogation 2018** was conducted at 1.30pm by Dr.P.R.Sisir, Faculty in-charge of Library. There were five teams in the Quiz competition from I,II,III & IV BHMS. Four students in each team from each class. The teams were named as A,B,C,D and E. The Programme was concluded at 9.30am by the vote of thanks by Dr. Suman Sankar, IQAC, Co-ordinator.

























While reading every remedy, a clear portrait of the patient with minute details comes out in front of us.George Vithoukas has given a description of the type of person most commonly affected by a remedy at the start of most remedy portraits, for e.g. the Kali carb patient with a strong sense of duty heightened to an inflexible,rigid degree.In every medicine Vithoukas has described a common thread/ theme going at all three levels of the patient, for e.g.in Alumina, the theme of delayed action and slowness is visible at all the three levels. She added that the book is reflective of the vast clinical experience and knowledge of Vithoukas. With this book, Vithoukas has carried the efforts of Kent in creating the remedy portraits to the next level.The book is well compiled and the presentation of the material is very lucid and systematic.

15<sup>th</sup> November – 2017

A debate on the Topic " Change in Reading habits in the Context of Social Media" was organized by Dr.P.Saravanan, Librarian, Arts and science college, Lekshmpuram. Few selected students from all batches
