





REPORT BREAST CANCER AWARENESS AND SCREENING CAMPAIGN (10/10/2015)

Saradakrishna Homoeopathic medical College Hospital that work extensively to reach out to women in underprivileged communities. The M.C.H unit and Palliative Care unit organize an awareness and screening program of breast cancer. Both units participate in campaigns to inform the public of the growing problem of breast cancer. The program was conducted inside the SKHMC hospital campus.

Breast cancer is the most common type of cancer among women. Currently, most patients are diagnosed at advanced stages of the disease, which reduces their chances of survival. The goal of our project was to expand the current awareness of breast cancer and breast cancer and its treatment among our rural population. The goal of our project was to provide accurate, accessible, and up-to-date information on breast cancer.

Team members

Two medical officers, three PG scholars, and six interns participated in the screening and awareness program.

Execution of the program.

- Screened the risk group for breast carcinoma, we find out few suspected cases and send them for confirmatory tests.
- About 87 cases were screened and 15 doubtful cases detected.
- 3. We can able to give awareness to about 120 ladies, and we feel they were benefited.
- We can able to clarify doubt of the groups related the subject.
- Subject related pamphlets are distributed among 1000 people.
- The existing breast cancer awareness campaigns in Kulasekharam should be expanded to reach a larger audience in order to make early detection of breast cancer logistically possible for all women.
- Women tend to seek emotional support services following diagnosis and during treatment.
 Breast cancer patients really in need of emotional support.
- There are several common misconceptions that people have about breast cancer and breast cancer treatments. We try to clarify them.

The programme was concluded with a vote of thanks by Dr.V.Santhi Serenc Sylum, H.O.D Department of Obstetrics and Gynaecology.

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
