Dear Principal,

As you are aware, Govt. of India launched Swachh Bharat Mission in 2014 aiming to achieve the goal of Swachh Bharat (Clean India).

Each Ministry/department implements its annual action plan on Swachh Bharat. Apart from this, each year a fortnight (Pakhwada) is dedicated by each Ministry /Department for taking up various activities on Swachhata in a more focused and intensified manner.

Hon'ble Prime Minister had advised that during Swachhata Pakhwada, the concerned Ministry/ Department should be deemed as a de-facto "Swachh Bharat Ministry/Department". Ministry of AYUSH is observing Swachhata Pakhwada from 16th to 30th October, this year & various activities are planned to create substantial impact on ground. It is pertinent that the Swachhata Pakhawada cannot made successful without the active involvement of state AYUSH departments.

May I therefore, request you to organise various activities /programmes involving students and teachers. The activities can be taken up within the college premises as well as in surrounding villages / localities with the active involvement of village Panchayats and common people. A list of activities that can be taken are enclosed which can be further modified as per local requirements. On the conclusion of Pakhwada, on 30th October, 2018, you may upload the brief detail alongwith photos / videos on your websites with copy to this Ministry. Best performing institutions would be considered for merit / commendation certificate.

Note for the CoS review meeting on Swachhata Pakhwada implementation

(16th October – 30th November 2018)

To make the Swachh Bharat Mission truly everyone's business, the Hon'ble PM envisaged participation of

all Union Ministries and Departments in achieving the goal of a Swachh Bharat. Swachhata Pakhwada, as an institution began in April 2016, and is one of the initiatives of Govt of India aimed at engaging all Union

Ministries and Departments intensively on Swachhata for 15 days in a year, each.

On several occasions, the Hon'ble PM has reiterated that the Pakhwada should not to be treated as a routine fortnight but should be fifteen days of solid and substantial work on Swachhata. It may be noted that the Swachhata Pakhwada is different from the annual Swachhata Action Plans (SAPs), which have been submitted by all Ministries/Departments as part of their budgets for the FY 2017-18 and 2018-19. Pakhwada Ministries must submit their Action Plans on the portal –

<https://swachhbharatmission.gov.in/SwachhSamiksha/index.aspx>. Activities performed against the submitted action plans may also be updated on the same portal in the form of reports, pictures, audio and

video materials. The Ministry of Drinking Water and Sanitation compiles all reports, prepares a monthly e-Newsletter and circulates it to the Cabinet Secretariat, PMO and all Gov/NIC email users. The importance.

given to the Swachhata Pakhwada can be gauged from the high level of monitoring and highlight it is given.

Over the past year, there has been a marked improvement in the engagement, quality and publicity of Pakhwada activities by various Ministries and Departments. The Ministries/Departments are taking conscious steps to take up activities, which are sustainable, over long-term and have pan India coverage. The Pakhwada activities, rather than being confined to office premises, are now reaching State and field offices of Ministries. During PRAGATI and as part of regular interaction with all Secretaries, the Prime Minister has urged to further intensify the Swachhata Pakhwada programme. The Hon'ble PM has even said that, during the Swachhata Pakhwada, the concerned Ministry should be deemed as a de-facto Swachh Bharat Ministry. The Cabinet Secretary will take a review meeting of Swachhata Pakhwada on

8th October at 15:15 hrs with the Secretaries of the following Ministries, which are observing their Swachhata

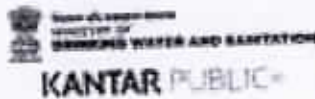
